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Step through a solid alder wood front door of this 8,670 square foot home into an airy entryway featuring rich cherry wood bookcases, hickory floors, vaulted ceilings and an open stairway of hickory with meticulously hand-crafted cherry inlays. The great room continues with a large, open fireplace which separates the living room from the dining room. Made of Kansas fieldstone, the fireplace features a mantle on the living room side custom carved by artisans in Missouri. The richly appointed formal dining room features cherry paneling, tile floors and large windows taking full advantage of the sweeping vistas.

The attached kitchen boasts a host of professional appliances, including a built-in Jenn Air double oven. There's also a large breakfast nook and a tile counter with additional eating space.

The spacious master suite of this 4 bedroom, 6-1/2 bath home has a cedar walk-in closet, vaulted ceiling with open beams, tile work on two walls and an attached bath featuring a Jacuzzi tub an separate shower.

The guest wing has three bedrooms, all with their own baths and closets with built-in drawers. Downstairs is an exercise room. A block glass wall between that room and the hallway takes full advantage of the abundant natural light.

But step into the library to catch your first glimpse of the home's real showpiece. The library, with built-in cherry bookcases and plush leather reading chairs, is a loft overlooking the home's cavernous trophy/media room, featuring 24-foot ceilings with open beams, massive windows and lush window treatments with leather cornice boxes. A hallmark of the trophy room is a spectacular bar meticulously hand crafted of cherry wood and Australian granite.

Up one more handmade hickory staircase is the home's observatory which provides panoramic views of Earth and sky.

A west-facing deck spans virtually the entire length of the house. Plumbing and drains run the entire length of the attached, heated three car garage. A detached four-car garage features an oversized door for recreational vehicles.
